- Wash your hands after handling animals or plants

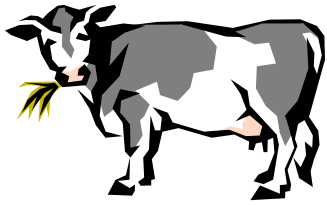
